GHC-Tri-State is moving towards a new registration process, where most all registrations should be completed using the GHC online portal, which is accessible to all members and non-members who have a profile within the computer system. The portal is accessible on desktops and smart phones, and although an app is not yet available, the portal can be saved like an app on the home screen of smart phones.

- Do not allow the registration process to be a hinderance to play. This is a new process. Please read
 the instructions below, and if you have any issues, still bring your child to class regardless. If help is
 needed to access the online portal, please contact the front desk 812-479-3111.
- Parents should be sure and sign beginners up for the age-appropriate group. Please read the
 descriptions on the first page.

Members & Returning Non-members do need to access their GHC online portal to register their player.

When using the portal, whether on a desktop or phone, be sure and hit the drop-down button in the top
right-hand corner and select your player's name under secondaries. This will ensure that parents and
guardians register each individual player and not a parent, by accident.

New Non-Members need to create a profile for each child by creating an account.

- Follow this link <u>www.mbrportal.genesishealthclubs.com</u> or use the QR code above. Make sure you are creating account for you first (The Parent). After creating an account, go to your email to confirm.
- Log in to your account. Go to the 3 lines at the top right and choose secondaries. From there you will add your children. Make sure to add birthdays and info.
- Once secondaries are added, select the child you want to sign up. Then go to the home page > Tennis > Programs. After selecting programs, you should see a button that says "Juniors" From here you can sign up and pay for classes!

Additional Information to Note:

- 1. The portal will automatically prorate the session fee, if the registration is completed after the start of the session. If a player has attended classes before completing the registration on the portal, the cost of the unpaid classes will be charged to the player's account, or an invoice will be sent to the email address on file.
- 2. Genesis does not issue refunds
 - · For medical disabilities, players will be allowed to make-up their remaining classes in a future session.
 - · A player who does not meet the skill level requirements will be moved to a compatible class
 - If any class is cancelled, Tri-State shall make every effort to reschedule the class, or the player can make-up another day.
- 3. A player is allowed to make-up if a class is missed.
